The Fund carries the name of Clyde E. Bailey, Sr., a distinguished patent attorney at the Eastman Kodak Company, who served as the 61st president of the National Bar Association, the oldest and largest bar association of African American judges, lawyers and legal scholars. President Bailey believed in promoting global cooperation among black communities long separated by geographic barriers. He worked to build relationships and a mutual understanding of common issues and concerns in achieving social, political and economic parity for historically disadvantaged people.
